Classes 1-5 in small arena, classes 6-10 in large arena, class 11-12 arena size dependent on test ridden. Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined and pinned as % class. Organizers reserve the right to add, combine or change classes as needed.

Awards: Ribbons 1st through 6th place. TIP High Point, Overall High Score and Overall USPC Member High Score Awards.

Attire: According to MSEDA/USEF rules. In case of inclement weather, appropriate clothing may be worn in lieu of show attire.
